Who should Consider Home Dialysis?

- \boxtimes Patients who are independent and manage their own care
- \boxtimes Patients who are interested in more flexibility with their daily life
- \boxtimes Patients who would like a more flexible diet

Why should I consider Home Dialysis?

- \boxtimes Less stress on the heart
- More energy, both mentally and physically
- \boxtimes Better control of blood pressure and usually, fewer medications
- \boxtimes Less recovery time after treatment

What type of support would be provided by my dialysis facility

- The Home nurse will provide one on one training until you are comfortable to dialyze at home
- \boxtimes The Home nurse will be available to you 24/7 either in the facility or by phone
- \boxtimes You will still have visits to the home facility for labs and evaluations
- \boxtimes The Home nurse will assist in organizing your home with supplies needed for dialysis
