2nd Priority Terms	Hospital Documentation
Discharge to PACU/recovery room	
Operating room end, finish, or stop time	
Room out time	
Time patient taken from surgery	
To PACU/recovery room	

If multiple times are found, abstract the earliest. None found? Move to 3rd priority.

ALL OF THE 2ND PRIORITY TERMS ARE DESCRIBING THE TIME THE PATIENT IS TAKEN OUT OF THE ROOM, MOVED TO PACU, ETC.

3rd Priority Terms	Hospital Documentation
Anesthesia end time	
Anesthesia stop time	
Arrival in the PACU/recovery room	

If multiple times are found, abstract the earliest.

ALL OF THE 3RD PRIORITY TERMS ARE DESCRIBING THE END OF THE ANESTHESIA PROCESS/RESPONSIBILITIES OR THE ACTUAL ARRIVAL TO PACU.
