- ❑ Use NHSN Analysis Output Options to verify accuracy and completion of data entry**

- ❑ Important to double- and triple-check this number!
- ❑ Must be completed by an administrative user (e.g., Facility Administrator)

Monthly Reporting Plan

- ❑ **The Monthly Reporting Plan informs CDC which modules a facility is following during a given month**
 - Referred to as “In-Plan” data
- ❑ **The Plan also informs CDC which data can be used for aggregate analyses**
 - This INCLUDES sharing CLABSI data with CMS!
- ❑ **A facility must enter a Plan for every month of the year**
- ❑ **Plans can be modified retrospectively**



Only “In Plan” CLABSI Data will be Shared with CMS

When NHSN releases 2011 CLABSI data to CMS for those hospitals participating in the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services' Hospital Inpatient Quality Reporting Program (CMS Reporting Program), only those months in which the facility included CLABSI in its NHSN monthly reporting plan (MRP) will be included (i.e., in Plan CLABSI). Therefore, it is vitally important that every facility participating in the CMS Reporting Program ensures that its MRPs include CLABSI surveillance participation for the months and locations they wish reported to CMS. As a reminder, only CLABSI identified in adult, pediatric, and neonatal critical care units (level III and level II/III) are included in the CMS Reporting Program. NHSN will not share with CMS CLABSI data for other patient care locations listed in the MRP.



- ❑ Facilities can verify the completion and accuracy of their data using the Analysis Output Options.
- ❑ Data entered into NHSN are immediately available for analysis
- ❑ First step is to Generate Datasets

Verify Completion & Accuracy of Data

- ❑ **When checking data, users should ask themselves:**
 - Is the number of CLABSIs accurate? If No, check the following:
 - Have all been entered into NHSN?
 - Is the location correct on each CLABSI?
 - Has “Central Line” been answered as ‘No’?- when this happens, the event is considered a non-CL BSI and would not be included in the CLABSI analyses!

Verify Completion & Accuracy of Data

□ When checking data, users should ask themselves:

- Are the denominators accurate (i.e., central line days and patient days)?
 - Check if the patient days or central line days seem unusual. For example, 1000 patient days were recorded instead of 100 patient days
 - Have denominator data for NICUs been entered appropriately (i.e., patient days, CL and UC days by birthweight)?

Verify Completion & Accuracy of Data

- ❑ **When checking data, users should ask themselves:**
 - Have all months been included for all of my ICU & NICU locations?
 - If a month is missing from the rate table, the summary data have not been entered!
 - May wish to check data by bsiPlan = Y


