***Guiding Principle(s) for Knowledge***

- a) It is important for everyone to understand what each other can do to eliminate MDROs in your organization.

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***Guiding Principles for Teamwork***

- a) Eliminating MDROs requires the cooperation of every person who steps foot into the building.
- b) Everyone's role includes providing feedback when a risky behavior is noticed.
- c) Everyone's responsibility includes taking immediate action to correct their own risky behavior when it is brought to their attention.

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***Guiding Principles for Hygiene Practices***

*(Staff, Environment, Patients, Visitors)*

- a) Cleanliness is paramount in eliminating MDROs.
- b) All equipment that comes into contact with patients has the potential to spread MDROs.
- c) "Hands" are the most basic pieces of equipment that come into contact with a patient.
