

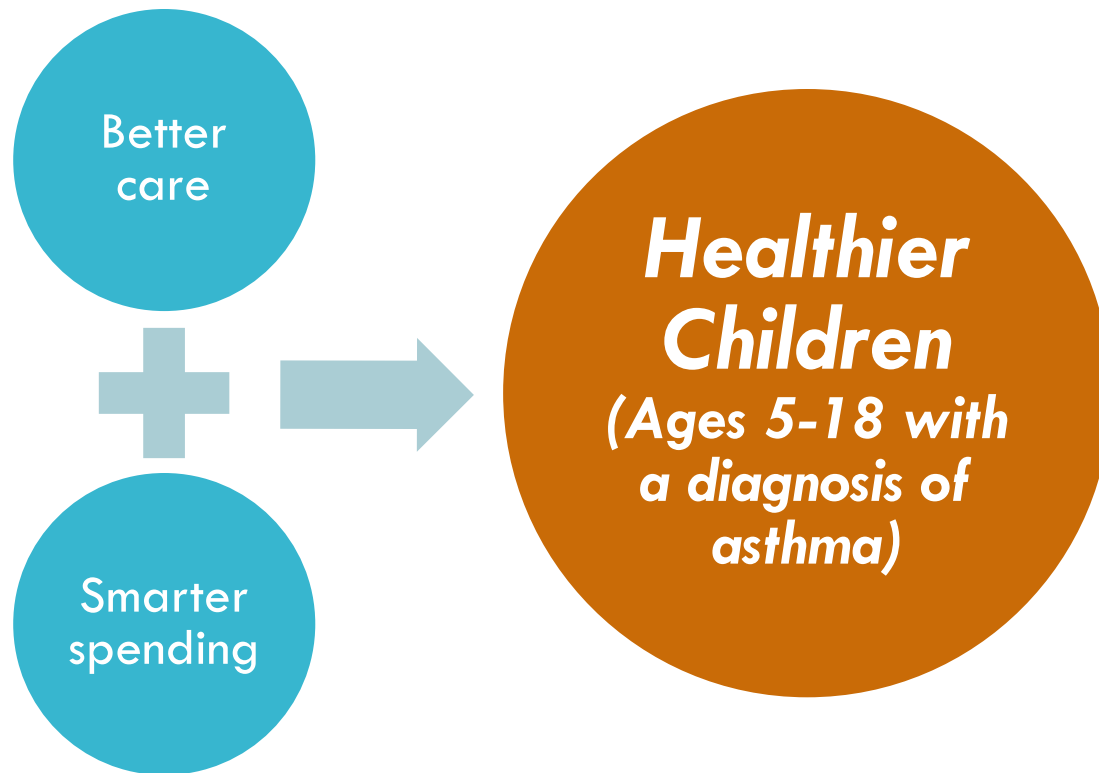
Florida Asthma and Tobacco Cessation Learning and Action Network

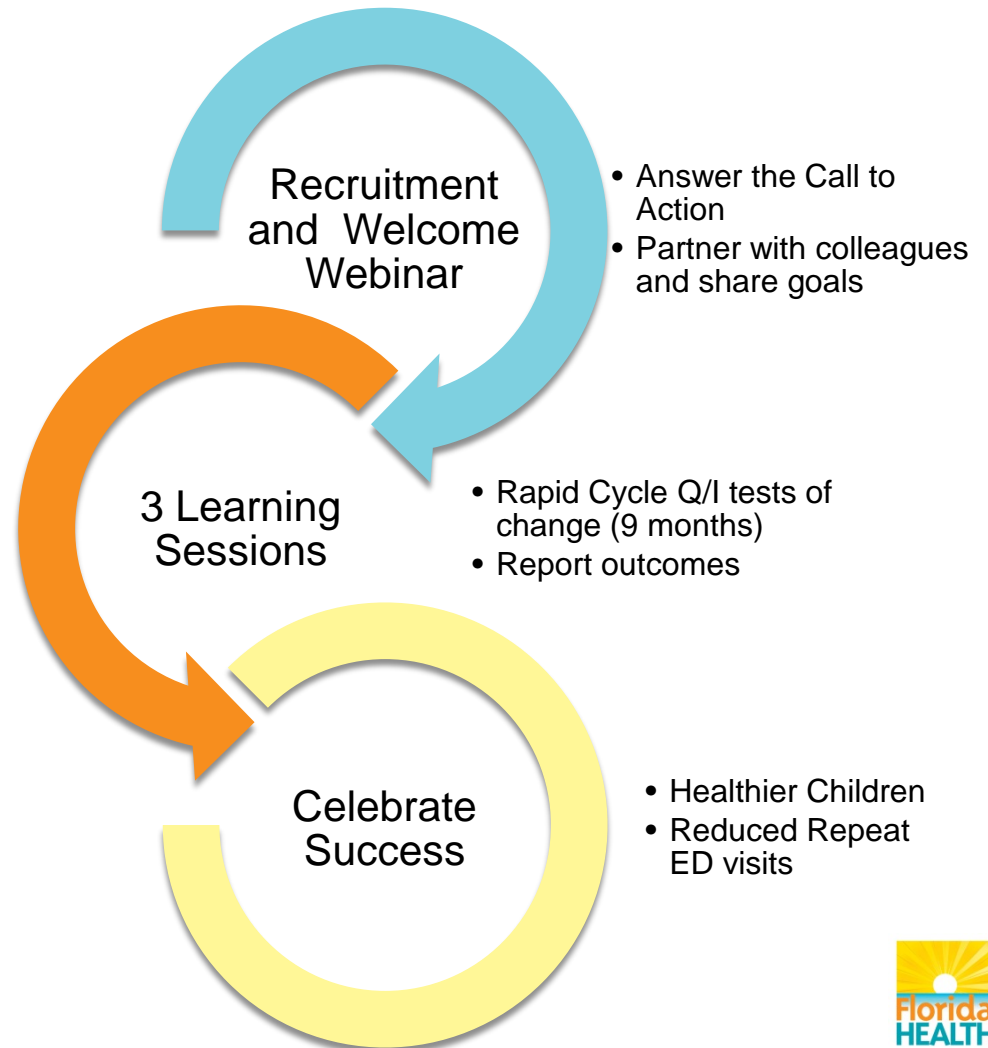
