Subject: FLHealthSTAT Introduction and Training

Beginning July 1, 2017, **FLHealthSTAT** will replace **EMResource** as the online database for reporting information regarding licensed health care facility emergency status, planning, or operations, as required by Section 408.821(4), Florida Statutes.

Developed by the Florida Department of Health (DOH) in conjunction with the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA), FLHealthSTAT will function comparably to EMResource, with improvements that will provide a more streamlined and user-friendly system for daily and emergency situational awareness and reporting of health care facility status and bed availability.

Introductory Webinars

To do this, log in to EMResource, select the 'Preferences' tab from the Menu Bar at the top of the screen, and choose 'User Info' to update your user contact information.
