CDPH Updates

State Public Health Officer Order: Health Care Worker Vaccine Requirement—Updated January 25, 2022

- Extended the deadline for healthcare workers to acquire their booster dose from February 1 to March 1, 2022.
- Workers not yet eligible for boosters by March 1, 2022, must be in compliance no later than 15 days after the recommended timeframe for receiving the booster dose.
- If an unvaccinated worker has an approved exemption, the worker must test with either a PCR or antigen test at least twice weekly.
- Booster-eligible workers who have not yet received their booster by December 27, 2021, must be tested with either a PCR or antigen test at least twice weekly.

As a best practice, CDPH strongly recommends that all nursing home workers (including those that are fully vaccinated and boosted) undergo at least twice weekly screening testing.

- NHSN will auto-populate the MRP for the vaccination coverage module so the data can continue to be submitted as required.
- **Facilities do not need to complete MRPs to report COVID-19 vaccination data for residents and healthcare personnel for reporting weeks ending **October 3, 2021, through March 27, 2022.****
