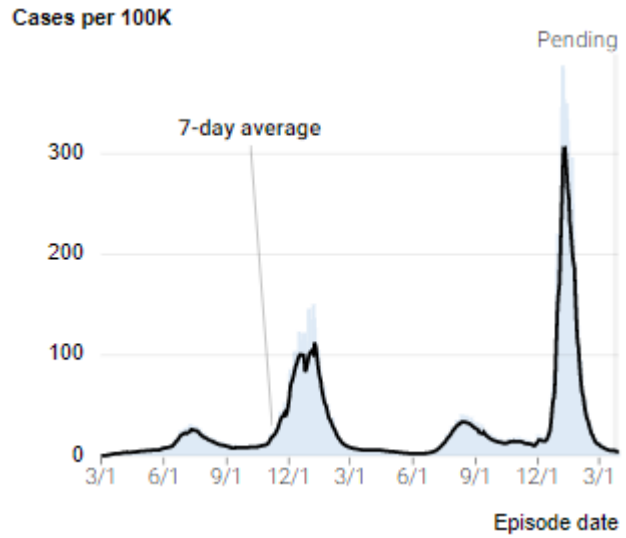
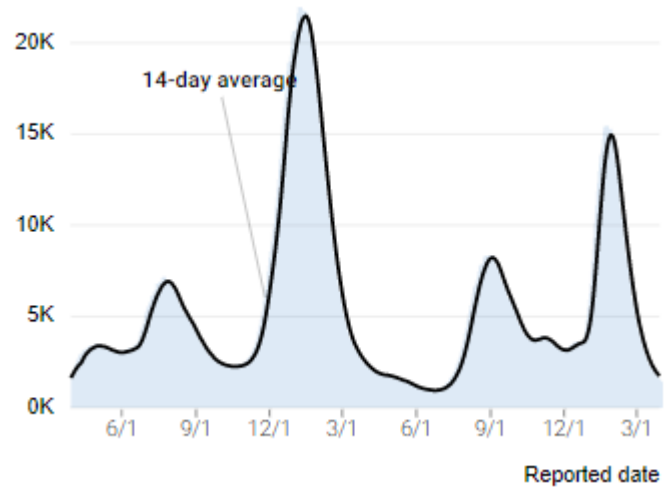


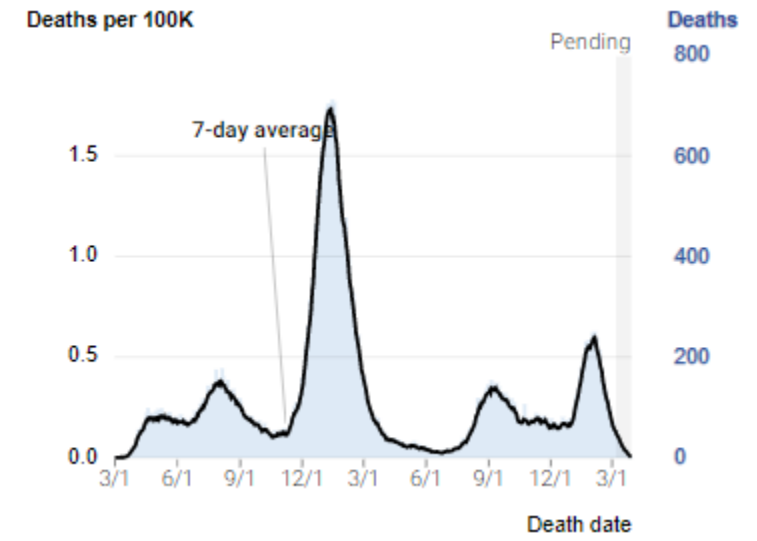
Testing Taskforce: New California COVID-19 cases, hospitalizations and deaths



14 day average Hospitalizations



7 day Average Deaths



Avg. test positivity past 7 days 1.3%, Up 0.1% from last week

Daily New cases numbers are similar to the lowest levels from last spring.

14 day average Hospitalizations are falling, still ~2 times higher than previous lows

7 day average Deaths are at the lowest they have been since the start of pandemic.

Test turnaround time improving: Avg. Turnaround time last week: 0.8 d

Turnaround time < 2 days: 97% Turnaround time < 1 day: 91%

DHCS uninsurance program

- Funding for testing for uninsured or for people whose health insurance does not cover testing
- The Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA) recently [announced](#) that the Uninsured Program will stop accepting claims for testing, treatment, and vaccination claims due to insufficient funds.
- DHCS will still accept claims for individuals enrolled in the [COVID-19 Uninsured Group Program](#). Individuals must apply for the COVID-19 Uninsured Group Program through a Medi-Cal Qualified Provider (QP). QPs are providers of the following programs: Presumptive Eligibility for Pregnant Women, Breast and Cervical Cancer Treatment Program, Hospital Presumptive Eligibility, and Child Health and Disability Prevention. Providers must submit applications via the [COVID-19 Uninsured Group Application Portal](#). Providers can submit their COVID-19 testing, testing-related, and treatment claims to DHCS for claims processing.
