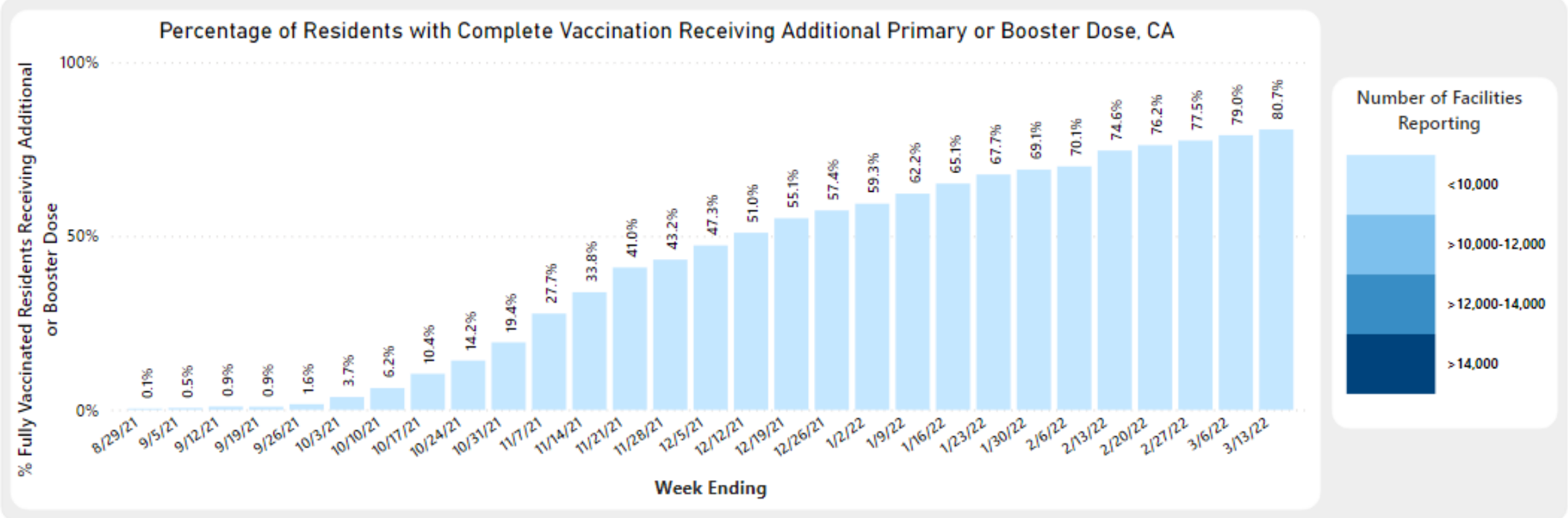

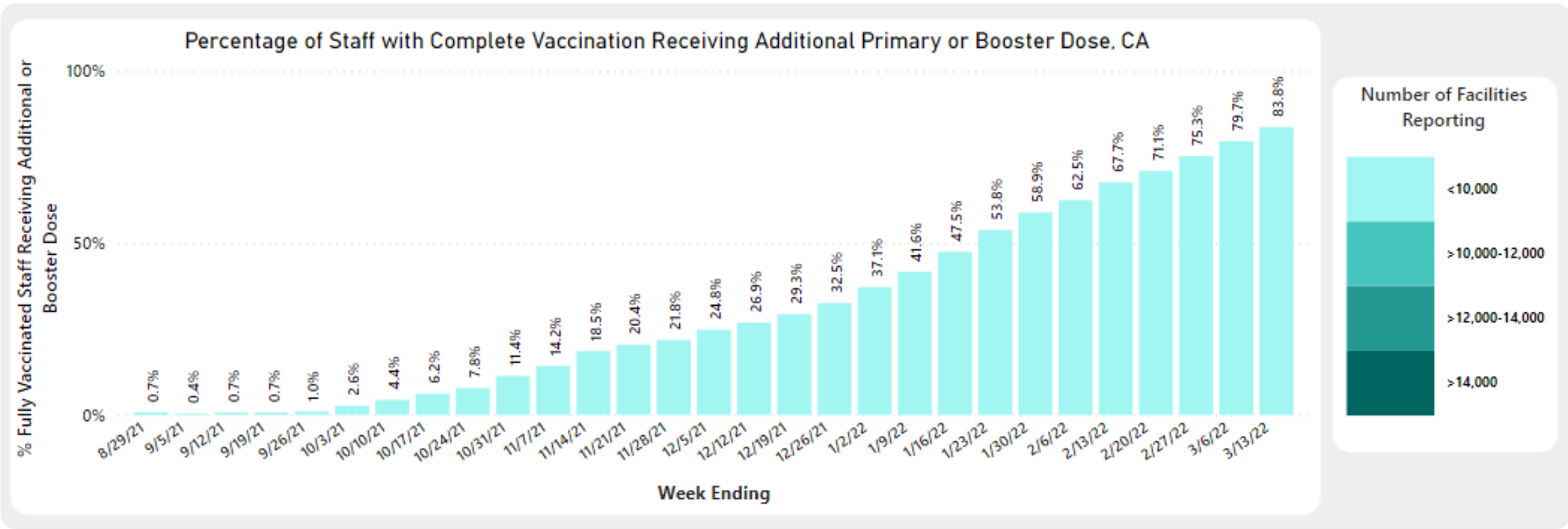
CA SNF Booster Rates: Residents

Second Booster?

- [Pfizer](#) and [Moderna](#) recently submitted requests to FDA for Emergency Use Authorization to allow for a second booster dose.
- No meetings are currently scheduled by FDA or CDC to discuss the second booster request.
 - FDA Vaccines and Related Biological Products Advisory Committee (VRBPAC) is [meeting on April 6th](#) to discuss considerations for future boosters, but no vote is planned.
- A few countries currently recommend a second booster for older people and LTC residents (Israel, UK, Sweden, Germany).


