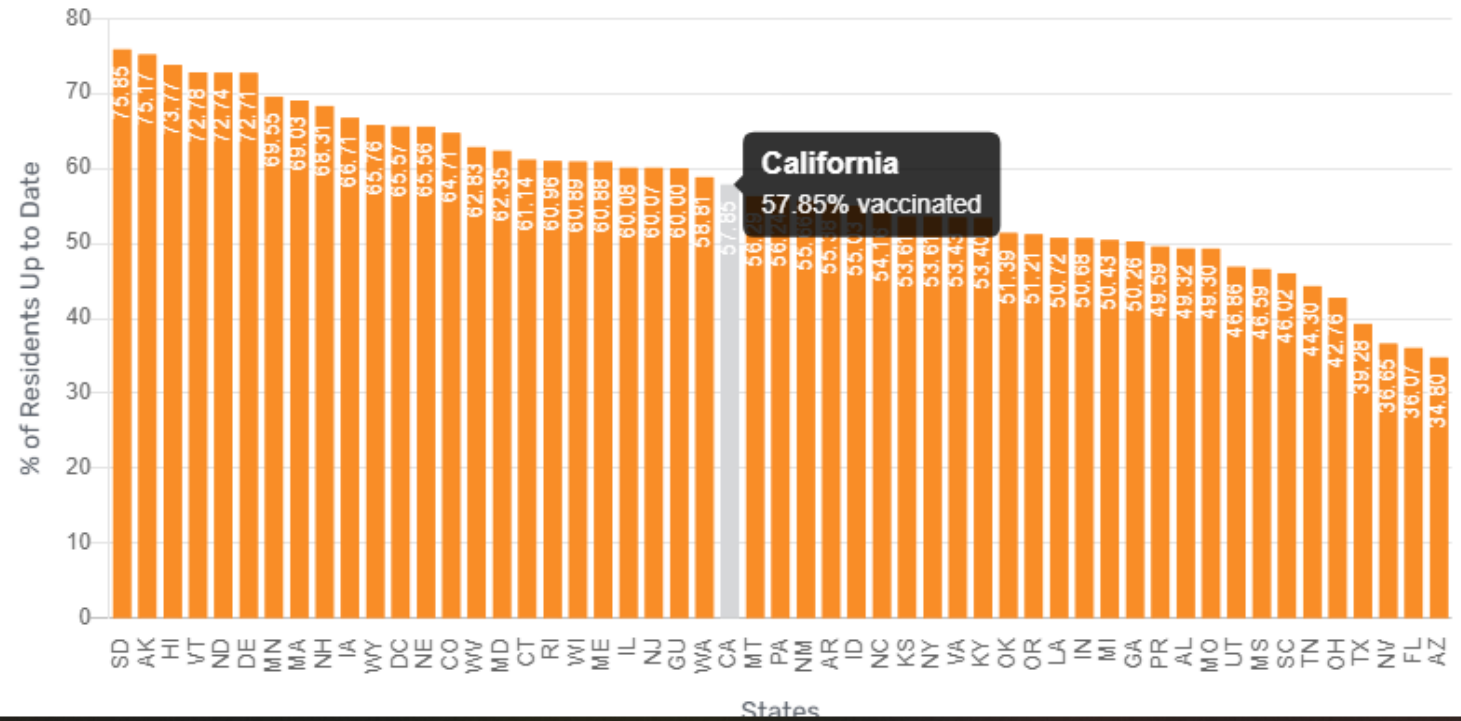

This shows the average percentage among facilities who have reported vaccination data in the current or prior week.

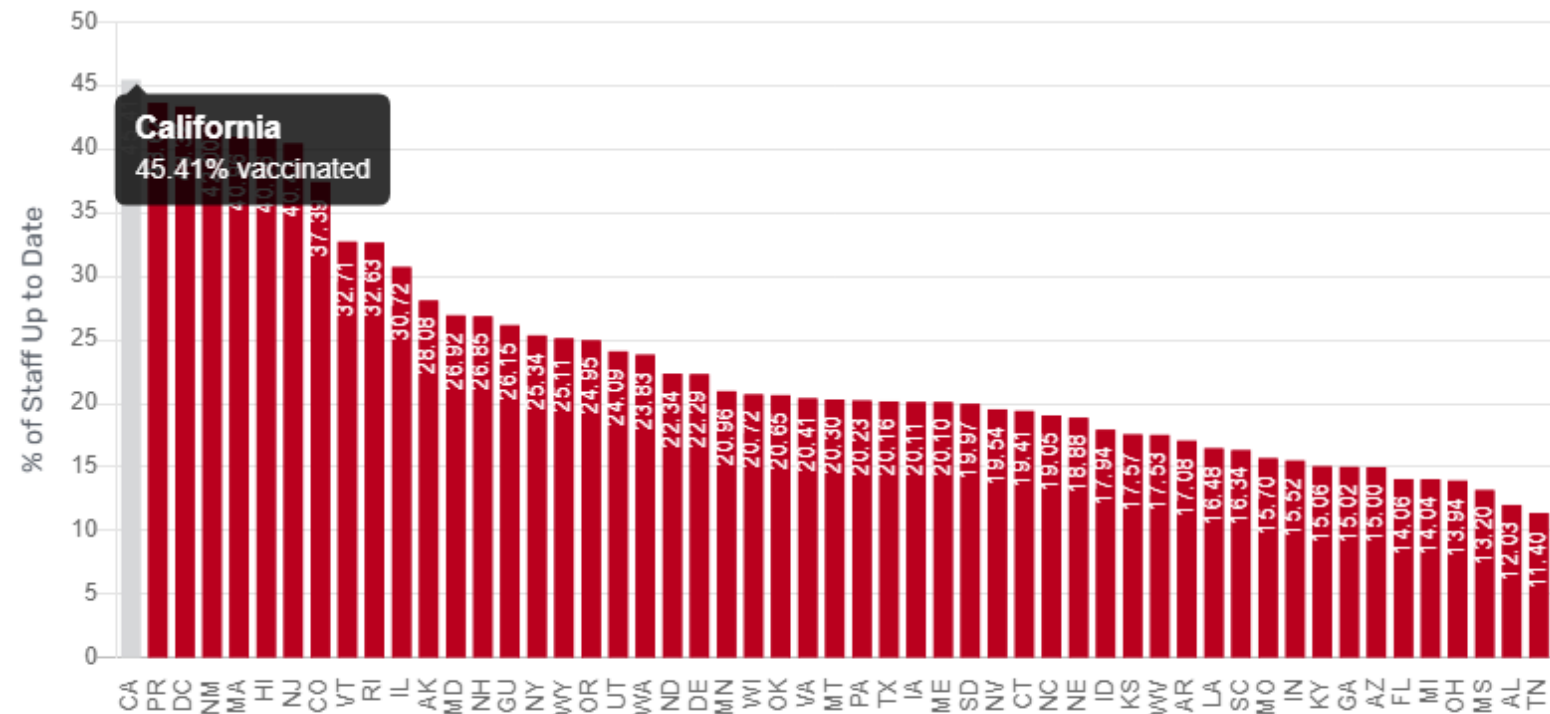


COVID-19 Nursing Home Data - Staff

CDC Morbidity & Mortality Weekly Report (MMWR)

COVID-19 Incidence and Mortality Among Unvaccinated and Vaccinated Persons by Receipt of Bivalent Booster Doses and Time Since Vaccination

- Case and mortality data for individuals ≥ 12 years in 24 U.S. jurisdictions, between October 3, 2021-December 24, 2022
- Bivalent boosters restored protection against mortality and provided similar protection against infection at 2 weeks through 2 months
- Limitations
 - Ecologic study – unable to adjust for confounding factors
 - Use of at-home tests affects case incidence trends
 - National variant prevalence estimates used
 - Potential misclassification of monovalent vs bivalent booster
 - Limited to 24 jurisdictions – may not be as generalizable

AN UPDATED COVID-19 VACCINE HELPS SAVE LIVES

Vaccinated people* who received an **updated COVID-19 vaccine** were

14X less likely to die

compared with those who received
no vaccine

3X less likely to die

compared with those who received
only the original COVID-19 vaccine(s)

People ages 12+ who got their last COVID-19 vaccine dose
before September 2022 should get an updated vaccine



* Completed the original COVID-19 vaccine primary series and/or original booster(s)
