Become a Facility Patient Representative (FPR)



Who is eligible to be an FPR?

You are! Network 7 is looking for patients, family members, and caregivers to represent their dialysis facility or transplant center and become an FPR. We need at least one patient per facility to serve as an FPR. FPRs are individuals who are on dialysis and/or who:

- Have chosen to volunteer to assist their facility.
- Have the desire to help improve the patient experience
- of care.
- Are available to meet with patients to discuss questions, challenges, or concerns related to their personal adjustment
- to dialysis.
- Are willing to represent the patient voice.
- Should be a positive example in their facilities.

What is Network 7?

Network 7 contracts with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and is dedicated to improving quality of care for people with end stage renal disease. We serve the state of Florida.

When would I be needed?

We are recruiting FPRs to work with the Network and their facilities now! FPRs must be willing to make a one-year commitment and must have an email address that is checked regularly.

Where would meetings be held?

All interactions with Network 7 will be done via email and/or phone. You will also work with staff and patients at your dialysis facility.

As an FPR, you may be asked to:

- Provide input into quality improvement activities.
- Write your story for the patient newsletter.
- Help develop/distribute patient education materials.
- Promote patient and family involvement in your facility.
- Complete a facility bulletin board and more!
