What is CAIR2?

A secure internet-based immunization registry for California

- Tracks patient immunizations and TB test information
- Reduces missed opportunities
- Increases immunization coverage rates
- Used by thousands of health care providers and other agencies in California
- Patients of all ages can be entered into CAIR2











Benefits of CAIR2

- Shows what shots are due, based on ACIP recommendations
- Keeps patient shot and TB test information in one location
- Prints the CA Immunization Record (Yellow Card)
- Tracks your vaccine inventory
- Generates Reports and Reminder/Recall postcards, letters, and lists





CAIR2 is Now Statewide!

All Healthy Futures (HF)/RIDE patients are now in CAIR2!

- All existing HF/RIDE patients are in CAIR2
- Updates to patient records and new records entered in HF/RIDE go into CAIR2 every 20 minutes
- HF/RIDE still maintains its own IZ Registry and HF/RIDE users only use the HF/RIDE Registry, they do not use CAIR2
- <u>Coming soon</u>: HF/RIDE users will have access to CAIR2 patient records within the HF/RIDE Registry and be able to add new CAIR2 patients to the HF/RIDE Registry






AB1797: Effective January 1, 2023

All California healthcare providers who administer vaccines are required to:

Enter/submit patient vaccination info to a CA Immunization Registry: CAIR2 or HF/RIDE

- All vaccinations given for all ages
- TB test results
- Race/Ethnicity

*NOTE: All vaccines should be reported to CAIR within <u>24 hours</u> of administration.

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Best Practices for All Immunization Providers

For all healthcare providers administering vaccines:

- Record vaccinations as soon as possible following administration
 - AB1797 requires documentation within 24 hours
- Each individual staff who requires CAIR access at your clinic <u>MUST</u> have their own:
 - Username
 - Password
 - Email Address

Sharing of usernames/passwords is <u>NOT</u> allowed.



Best Practices for All IZ Providers (cont'd)

- CAIR Users should login at least 1x/month
 - After >90 days without login, accounts are automatically locked.
 - Regular/Power users must re-take training after >6 months without login.
- Have a designated "Primary CAIR Contact" at your organization
 - Responsible in following up with CAIR to address CAIR questions, issues, and/or Account Updates.
- Enter all doses correctly based on whether they are Historical or Administered at your site.



Best Practices for Covid, Flu & MPOX IZ Providers

Sites who give <u>ONLY</u> COVID, Flu and/or MPOX vaccinations must use <u>MyTurn</u> or <u>CAIR Data Exchange (DX)</u> to submit these doses to CAIR.

• Applies to all new sites enrolling in CAIR and existing sites not yet submitting immunization info to CAIR.

<u>NOTE</u>: A site does *not* need to be a Covid provider to use MyTurn.

- MyTurn now includes CAIR Quick Entry (CQE) and bulk-upload features and accepts all vaccines.
- MassVax is now retired. Sites must transition to MyTurn or DX

Benefits of MyTurn/CAIR Quick Entry (CQE)

- MyTurn/CAIR Quick Entry (CQE) is ideal if your clinic does <u>NOT</u> provide routine immunizations, but occasionally participates in pop-up or mobile clinic events for Covid, Flu and/or MPOX vaccine(s).
- CQE can also be used to report data for <u>ALL</u> vaccines accepted by CAIR.
- Direct CAIR usernames are not required for MyTurn/CQE you will have your own MyTurn access, separate from CAIR.
- However, QA or Read-Only user accounts may be requested for staff who need access to print IZ records for their patient via CAIR.
- *Regular/Power* user accounts are not necessary for MyTurn/CQE sites.



Notes for Adding Historical Combo Shots

The **Add Historical Imms** screen now displays a note for historical combination vaccines:

When a CAIR user enters a combination vaccine, it is only necessary to enter a date for one of the antigens. When the **Add Details** button is clicked and a trade name is selected, the dates will auto-populate for the remaining antigens in the combo vaccine.

Tick-Borne Encephalitis Vaccine Series Added

Adult and Child Series Added Both are invoke-on-use (not routinely recommended).



CAIR Individual User Access Agreement

CAIR Providers/Organization Terms & Conditions

The California Immunization Registry (CAIR) is a secure, computerized online information system developed to assist medical providers and other approved organizations/entities to track and review immunization information and tuberculosis (TB) test results for individuals, assess immunization needs and remind/recall patients, avoid unnecessary or redundant immunizations, and control disease outbreaks. Information in CAIR is only available to authorized users. Based on the access level approved, this agreement will allow the organization to access, view, add, or modify immunization information/TB test results in CAIR either via the web interface or through electronic data exchange under the conditions listed below. As conditions for participating in CAIR, the organization agrees to:

- Comply with California Health and Safety Code Section 120440 regarding immunization registry use, as well as state and federal laws and regulations regarding maintaining the confidentiality of patient information.
- Ensure your organization staff receive required CAIR training per their designated user role prior to accessing information in CAIR.
- Access information in CAIR only as needed to perform immunization/TB-related activities for individuals presenting to your provider/organization for services.
- Safeguard and ensure no sharing of assigned passwords or user accounts.
- Ensure no misuse or wrongful disclosure of information in CAIR by your organization staff.
- Disclose to patients or their parents/guardians, as required by Health & Safety Code Section 120440, subdivision (e), that state law allows patient immunization records/TB test results to be shared with CAIR and that patients have the option to share their immunization records/TB test results with all CAIR providers or only their primary provider. Written disclosure is highly recommended.
- Report any activity that may compromise the protection and privacy of the information in CAIR.
- Each user will have a unique email address.
- No false data shall intentionally be added to CAIR.

CAIR Individual User Terms & Conditions

California Health and Safety Code Section 120440 limits access to CAIR to authorized users who require the information for the purpose of providing immunization services as specified.

As a condition of authorized access to CAIR, I agree:

- To only access and use the registry system in the course of my assigned duties for the purposes stated above.
- To keep my user account and password confidential.
- To only use my own user account and password to access the registry.
- · To maintain the privacy and confidentiality of information in the registry.
- To not communicate, publish, and/or otherwise provide or make public any information regarding persons enrolled in the registry and their immunization status, except:
 - 1. To patients who request their own immunization records;
 - 2. To individuals authorized by law to access immunization registry information; or
 - 3. When records are presented in aggregate reports and have no associated identifying information.

To assure appropriate usage of CAIR, a permanent electronic record will be created that will log each user's access into any registry client record. Any unauthorized release of confidential information by a user may result in revocation of the user or the user's organization's access to CAIR. User accounts will be automatically inactivated by CAIR if a user fails to login to CAIR for a period of 90 days.

CAIR staff retain the authority to deactivate user accounts at their sole discretion in response to any violation of the Terms & Conditions. This includes, but is not limited to, the unauthorized sharing of accounts or passwords.




