






The Current State of Boosters in Arizona and California

What It Is Like To Be A New IP





General Role of the Nursing Home IP

Develop, direct, implement, manage, and operationalize facility IP program.

Identify, investigate, monitor, and report HAIs* and communicable diseases.

Nursing Home IP

Ensure adherence with organizational standards, professional guidelines, and regulations.

Collaborate with teams and individuals to create, educate, and sustain IP strategies.


Environmental Services (EVS)

- Questions to drive success?
 - Does your facility's IP understand the competencies and training of the EVS staff who are performing cleaning and disinfection in the facility?
 - Focus areas include daily cleaning (especially of high-touch surfaces), terminal cleaning, and special isolation rooms, etc.
 - How often does the IP meet with the EVS leadership?
 - Is EVS a part of the IP committee?
 - Does EVS track and trend quality assurance metrics?



2. Review NHSN FAQ

3. Enroll into NHSN

Register with the SAMS Partner Portal to access facility's NHSN account

- California: Daily Reporting and Weekly Testing (<u>AFL</u> 20-43) and Vaccination Reporting (<u>AFL</u> 20-60)

Local Health Department
