





Three Key Questions for Weekly COVID-19 Vaccination Modules

- Number of current residents (or HCP)?
- Number of these individuals who have ever been vaccinated (cumulative number vaccinated)?
- 3. Number of these individuals not receiving vaccination due to medical contraindications or exclusions?
