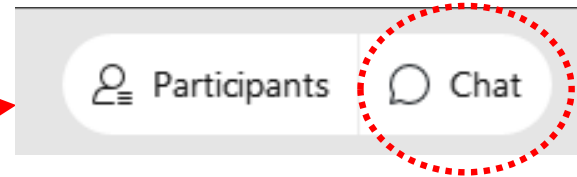

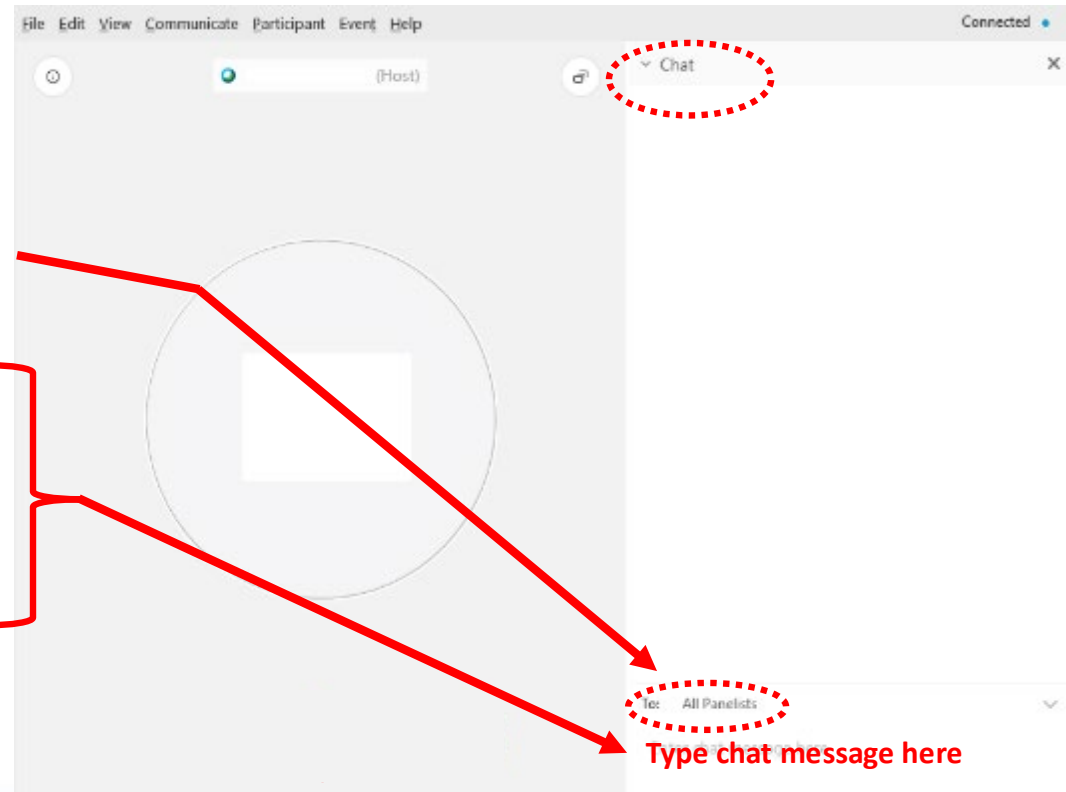

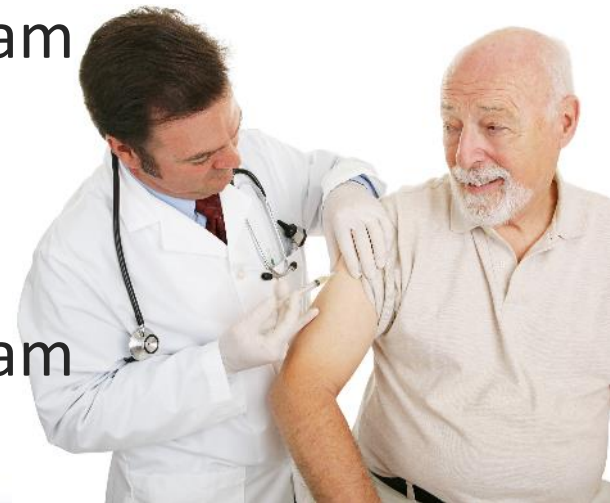

# CDC Vaccine Data: First Two Weeks

## December 28, 2020–January 10, 2021

- Total California facilities in Federal Pharmacy Partnership Program (FPP): 17,400
  - 855 SNFs (not including LA county)
  - 16,545 Assisted Living Facilities (ALFs) and other
- 2,872 clinics scheduled thus far
  - 776 SNFs = 90% of total SNFs in program
  - 2,096 ALFs and other
- 500 clinics completed thus far
  - 477 SNFs = 55% of total SNFs in program
  - 23 ALFs and Other



# California Doses Administered in CDC System as of January 11, 2021

	Resident Doses Administered	Staff Doses Administered	Total Doses Administered
SNFs	23,451	31,613	<b>55,064</b>
ALFs and Other	1,190	535	<b>1,725</b>
<b>Total</b>	<b>24,641</b>	<b>32,148</b>	<b>56,789</b>

    - 1,822 CVS
    - 238 Walgreens
