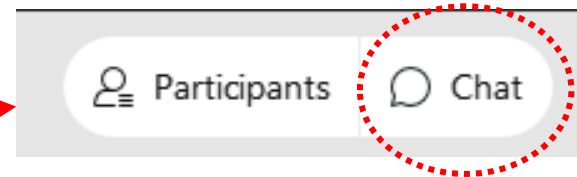

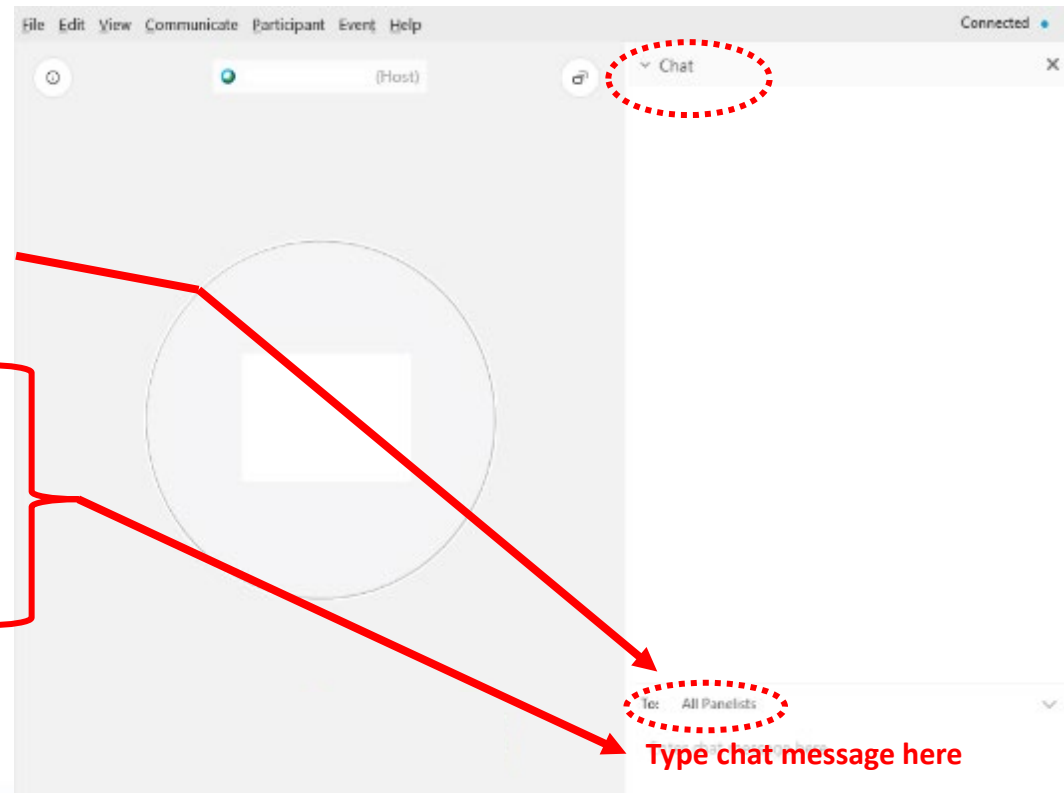

1. To submit a question, click on the **Chat Button** located in the bottom right corner of your Webex window.



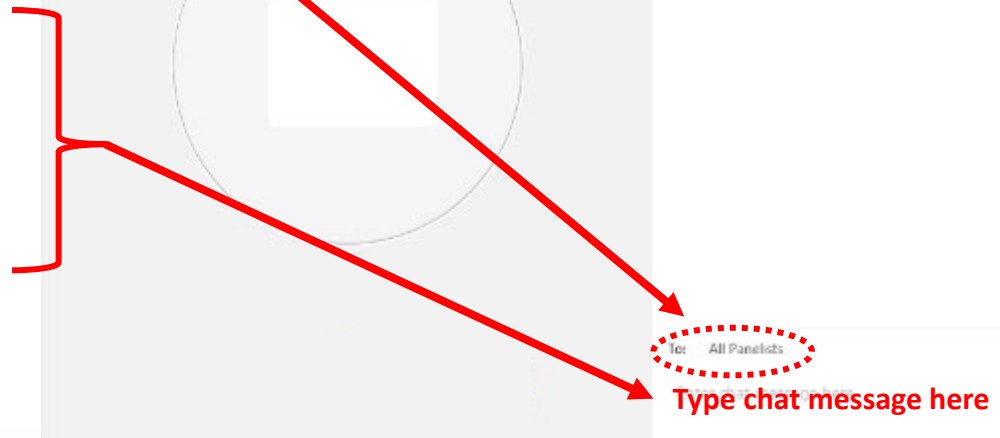
2. The **Chat** panel will open on your right.

MRP – cont'd

- NHSN will auto-populate the MRP for the vaccination coverage module so the data can continue to be submitted as required.
- **Facilities do not need to complete MRPs to report COVID-19 vaccination data for residents and healthcare personnel for reporting weeks ending **October 3, 2021** through **March 27, 2022**.**

COVID-19 Vaccine: HCW – cont'd

Data Field *Required fields	Instructions
*Employee HCP (Staff on facility payroll)	All persons receiving a direct paycheck from the healthcare facility (i.e., on the facility's payroll), regardless of clinical responsibility or patient contact.
*Non-Employee HCP (Licensed independent practitioners: Physicians, advanced practice nurses, & physician assistants)	-MD, DO, NP, PA Affiliated with the healthcare facility, but are not directly employed by it (i.e., they do not receive a paycheck from the facility), regardless of clinical responsibility or patient contact. -Post-residency fellows
*Non-Employee HCP (Adult students/trainees & volunteers)	-Medical, nursing, or other health professional students, interns, medical residents, or volunteers aged 18 or older that are affiliated with the healthcare facility, but are not directly employed by it (i.e., they do not receive a paycheck from the facility), regardless of clinical responsibility or patient contact.
*Non-Employee HCP (Other Contract Personnel)	Persons providing care, treatment, or services at the facility through a contract who do not meet the definition of any other required denominator category.
