CDC Federal Pharmacy Partnership Update

- CVS & Walgreens will give dose #1 at clinic #3
- CVS & Walgreens will not be returning to facilities for additional vaccine clinics
- It is the responsibility of the facility to arrange for dose #2 for staff and residents
- Pharmacy Partnership Program is projected to finish by March 31st, 2021

Current Options for Dose #2 (off site)

- In-store pharmacy appointments:
 - CVS, Walgreens, and Rite Aid are offering in-store appointments; Pfizer vaccine is available at selected locations
 - Walgreens will be doing outreach to schedule in-store appointments for dose #2
- Usual healthcare provider
- Local health department vaccine clinics
- Mass vaccination clinic sites

COVID-19 Vaccination in SNFs after the FPP

- Plans are in development, final options pending but may include
 - Arrangements with long-term care pharmacies
 - Arrangements with retail pharmacies for additional site visits
 - Partnership with local health departments
 - Partnership with local healthcare facilities
