1. To submit a question, click on the **Chat Button** at the center of the bottom navigation buttons.

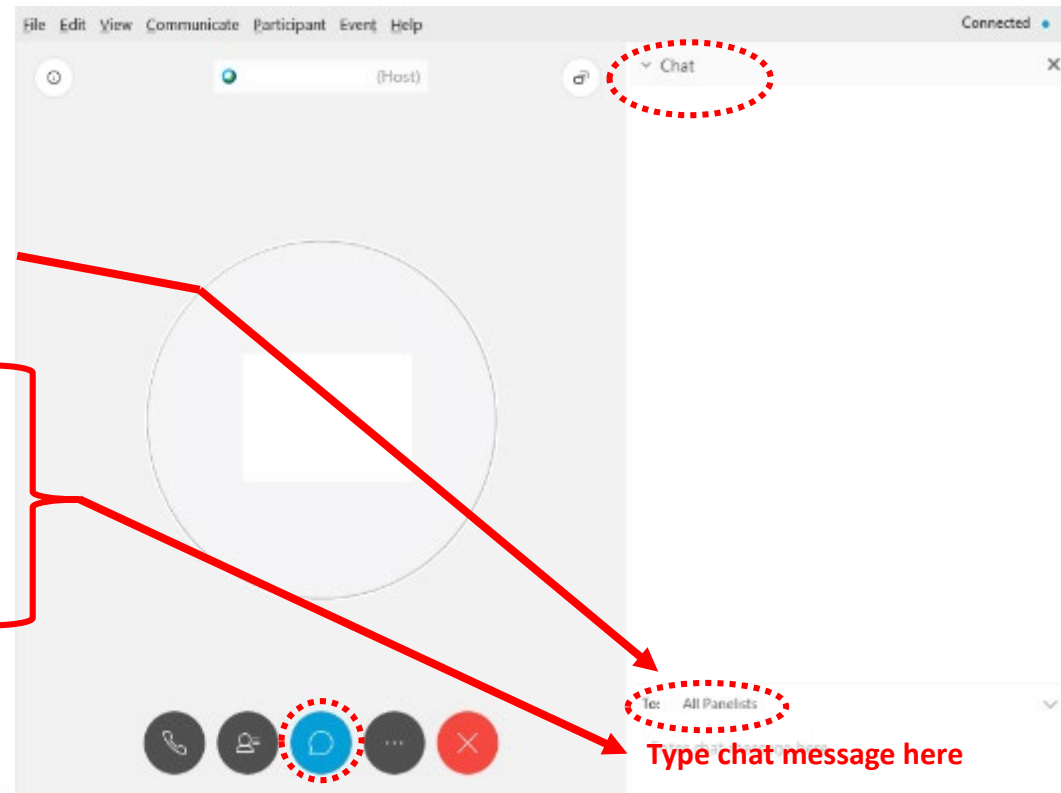


2. The **Chat** panel will open on your right.

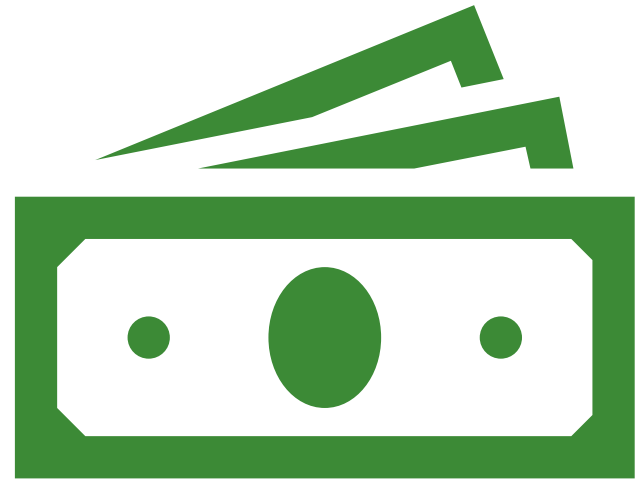
# Donning and Doffing PPE Video

- CDC video: gowns, masks, and other PPE look different from what the nursing home was using
- Created their own video:
  - In their own surroundings
  - Using their own PPE
  - Demonstrated by their own staff members



# IP Compliance Engagement Incentive

- Fun way to make sure staff are compliant with IP strategies
- Created *IP cash*
- Get a dollar/lose a dollar



# Doff-icer Program

- IP is everyone's responsibility, not just IP staff
- Designate a “doff-icer”
- “All hands on deck”
