## Testing Task Force Update

New tests reported: 133,078

Down from peak of ~360,000 tests/day in early January

Average test positivity

past 7 days : **7.0**%

up 0.8% from last week, and up 6.2% from early June

Average test turnaround time last week: 1 days

• < 2 days: 94%

• < 1 day: 81%



## Reminders

- Everyone should test regardless of vaccination status if:
  - They have symptoms of COVID-19
  - After exposure to COVID-19 (3-5 days after)
  - 3-5 days after international travel
  - Required by their work
- People who are unvaccinated should test before and 3-5 days after:
  - Large indoor or mass gatherings
  - Competing in high-risk sports
  - Events in crowded or poorly-ventilated settings
  - Travel (domestic or international)
- To reduce the spread of COVID-19 the most important thing you can do is to increase vaccination rates!
- Testing provides infection status at a given time. An unvaccinated individual can be infected at any point. Vaccination is the best way to prevent infection, reduce the spread of COVID-19, and keep people healthy!

## Reminders

- Antigen and PCR tests are just as effective for the Delta Variant as other COVID-19 strains
- Medical directors can issue standing orders to test visitors and staff
- All positive antigen results should be reported to CALREDIE or NHSN
