

Did You Know...?

- That if you are interested in talking to someone about working full- or part-time, you can start with just a conversation, **no commitment required!**
- Your dialysis social worker can connect you with an agency called, Work Incentives Planning and Assistance Projects (WIPA), that provides individual guidance at no cost to people just like you. People who:



- Currently receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) benefits.
- Think going to work again might be something they are interested in doing.
- Are on dialysis either in the clinic or at home.
- The staff at the WIPA office:
 - Understand the rules of specific work incentives and how they apply to you.
 - Decide whether the Ticket to Work program is right for you.
 - Understand the potential benefits of employment for a person who receives disability benefits from Social Security and can dispel myths about working.
 - Analyze how work and earnings may impact your SSI, SSDI, healthcare, and other public benefits.
 - Understand the services provided by State Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) agencies and Employment Networks (ENs) and how they might fit best with your needs.
 - Can help you achieve your work, career, and/or training goals.
